

Virtual Training Series on CSEC/CSAM: Social Media Awareness



DESCRIPTION

In this session, the presenter will share how human trafficking is depicted on social media and how people react to content about human trafficking across different platforms. Attendees will learn what content engagement is, how social media spreads awareness and misinformation, and how to distinguish between the engagement of myths and facts about human trafficking. Lastly, factors that influence content engagement will be identified and discussed.

ABOUT THE PRESENTER

Dr. David Deeds

Dr. Deeds brings over 15 years of experience researching and raising awareness about human trafficking. In that time, he has hosted events, engaged legislators, and found innovative ways of working against human trafficking while informing others. He has conducted a content analysis on more than 5,000 pages of textbooks that revealed criminal justice students are exposed to very little literature on human trafficking in higher education. Additionally, Dr. Deeds doctoral capstone work focused on educator pedagogy to investigate a possible gap in student understanding of human trafficking, the educators. Beyond research, Dr. Deeds has worked with nonprofits for more than six years and has helped design a roll-call training to help police officers identify human trafficking victims.
