



JELLYFISH CHORE LIST

Used For:

Parenting - Routine

Why it is important:

Jellyfish chores charts are a fun and easy way for children to keep track of their daily chores and to-do lists.

Supplies Needed

- Paper Jellyfish Cut-Out
- Paper Eyes
- Half Inch Strips of Colored Paper
- Tape, Glue, or Stapler
- Markers

Detailed Description:

Cut out the jellyfish template and glue the eyes to the body. On each strip of paper, write down one chore the child is meant to complete daily. Tape, glue, or staple the first two rings of paper to the body of the jellyfish. Repeat with the remaining strips of paper to create the jellyfish's tentacles. When the child has completed a task, the strip of paper can be removed from the tentacle.

Examples of daily chores or tasks:

- Wash dishes
- Take out trash
- Put toys away
- Take bath/shower
- Get dressed
- Make my bed
- Put clothes away
- Set table
- Clean room
- Homework
- Feed pet
