### OBJECTIVES:

1. Participants will be able to distinguish between developmentally appropriate sexual behaviors and problematic sexual behaviors.
2. Participants will gain knowledge on research-informed guidelines to keep kids with problematic sexual behaviors in the home and school.
3. Participants will learn the referral process to evidence-based therapy (Problematic Sexual Behavior Cognitive Behavioral Therapy) provided by the DCAC for children ages 3-18 who are displaying problematic sexual behavior.

**Eneida Vilella-Loraas**, MA, LPCC-S is a bilingual therapist at the Dakota Children's Advocacy Center. She provides several evidence-based treatments to youth and their families affected by trauma in Spanish and English. Eneida assisted in the launch of the Telehealth Outreach Program for Traumatized Youth in North Dakota, and is a telehealth co-trainer nationwide.
